In 2023, HealthPRO Canada launched its Member-Led Sustainability Committee (MLSC) which is currently comprised of more than 20 dedicated participants, including sustainability experts, representing healthcare organizations across the country. The MLSC meets six times per year and focuses on discussing best practices, sharing pain points, and developing practical solutions.

Employee Health & Wellbeing





World-Class Health Benefits Our commitment to healthcare sustainability means that the health of our employees is a top priority. Our employees receive world-class extended health and wellness benefits, including substantial mental health coverage, from their first day. HealthPRO Canada empowers its employees to lead healthy lives, professionally and personally, through flexible work schedules and work-life balance.



Hybrid Work HealthPRO Canada is committed to a hybrid work policy that encourages staff to work remotely three days per week. This has the added benefit of reducing carbon emissions associated with office commuting.



Indoor Air Quality Through the facility's Building Automation System (BAS), optimal indoor air quality is ensured for all workers, eliminating the risk of "Sick Building Syndrome." This system is automatically activated to circulate fresh air into the office space once the 900 PPM threshold is reached. Waste reduction is also prioritized by changing air handler filters only once the pressure differential reading surpasses an optimal limit.



Live Indoor plants Our commitment to enhancing staff wellbeing includes using plants to improve air quality.







Responsible Procurement



Our Sustainability Scorecard assesses a supplier's sustainability maturity against environmental, social and economic criteria.



Sustainability Tools HealthPRO Canada has developed digital tools to help members evaluate the carbon footprint associated with their purchase of specific pharmaceutical products, including Metered Dose Inhalers (MDIs) and anesthetic gases.



Our quarterly **Sustainability Rounds Pathway Series** webinars educate our members on social and environmental sustainability topics that lead to positive impacts to the health and resilience of the environment, our communities and the healthcare sector.



The Canadian Council for Aboriginal Business (CCAB) has designated HealthPRO Canada as an Aboriginal Procurement Champion.
